1 Respective responsibilities of the body and the auditor

Our responsibility as auditors to complete a **limited assurance review** is set out by the National Audit Office (NAO). A limited assurance review is **not a full statutory audit**, it does not constitute an audit carried out in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK & Ireland) and hence it **does not** provide the same level of assurance that such an audit would. The UK Government has determined that a lower level of assurance than that provided by a full statutory audit is appropriate for those local public bodies with the lowest levels of spending.

Under a limited assurance review, the auditor is responsible for reviewing Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with NAO Auditor Guidance Note 02 (AGN 02) as issued by the NAO on behalf of the Comptroller and Auditor General. AGN 02 is available from the NAO website – <https://www.nao.org.uk/code-audit-practice/guidance-and-information-for-auditors/>.

This authority is responsible for ensuring that its financial management is adequate and effective and that it has a sound system of internal control. The authority prepares an Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with Proper Practices which:

- summarises the accounting records for the year ended 31 March 2022; and
- confirms and provides assurance on those matters that are relevant to our duties and responsibilities as external auditors.

2 External auditor report 2021/22

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The AGAR was not accurately completed before submission for review:

- The smaller authority has confirmed that it has no confidence in the prior year figures. The current year's accounts have been prepared on a receipts and payments basis using the opening bank position as the opening balance in Section 2, Box 1. The smaller authority has been unable to restate the prior year to be on the same basis as required by the Practitioners' Guide. Additionally, as a result of this, the smaller authority has been unable to provide an adequate explanation for the variance between the prior and current year values in Box 3 of Section 2.

Assertion 3 has been incorrectly completed. The smaller authority was issued a statutory recommendation for non-submission of the AGAR for the 2020/21 year on 22/09/21. There is no evidence in the Minutes that the statutory recommendation was discussed at a public meeting in accordance with the requirements of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Hence the answer to this assertion should have been 'No'.
